

play mode E – youth / U 11 born 2008/09

Preliminary round:

Eight groups at all, 8 groups of 6 teams. In each group every team plays against each other. The ranking is determined over the obtained results in each case.

Last sixteen:

The winning teams and the second placed teams play crossways based on the k.o. system. If the match is undecided after the regular playing time, then there will be a 9m penalty shoot-out. The winner is qualified for the quarter final; the losers play for the places 9-16.

Quarter final:

The winners of the last sixteen round meet as stated on the provided match schedule to play the quarter finals. If the match is undecided after the regular playing time, then there will be a 9m penalty shoot-out immediately to decide which team goes through to the semi final. The losers play for the places 5-8.

Semi final:

The winners of the quarter finals meet in the semi final, as stated on the provided match schedule. One semi final will be played in **Kirchberg** and the other one in **Reith**. If the match is undecided after the regular playing time, then there will also be a 9m penalty shoot-out to decide the winner. Both winners are qualified for the final, which will be played in **Hopfgarten**. Both losers play for the places 3 and 4, which is also played in **Hopfgarten**.

Final:

Both winners of the semi finals play the final in **Hopfgarten**. If the match is undecided after the regular playing time, then there will be a 9m penalty shoot-out.

9 m – Penalty shoot-out:

If a match is undecided after the regular playing time, then there will be a 9m penalty shoot-out immediately, whereby **3 players** of each team, who were on the pitch up to the end of the game, will be chosen. In case of a draw after the shooting of these 3 players, the penalty shooting continues according to the knock out system. The shoot-outs must be taken from different players. A player can shoot a second time only if the 7 players of each team have done their shoot-out. A player is not allowed to be substituted for just the 9m penalty kick.

Placement Games:

The sixth placed teams of each group play for the places 41 - 48. Whereby each team has to play 3 more games. The last placement games will be out-played.

The fifth placed teams of each group play for the places 33 - 40. Here the same playing mode applies as for the places 41 - 48. All teams have three more games.

The fourth placed teams of each group play for the places 25 - 32. Here also the same playing mode applies as stated above. All teams have three more games.

The third placed teams of each group play for the places 17 - 24. Here also the same playing mode applies as stated above. All teams have three more games.

The losers of the last sixteen round play for the places 9 – 16. The final ranking for the places 9/10 – 11/12 – 13/14 – 15/16 will be determined on a direct comparison of the results at the other football ground. All teams have three more games.

The losers of the quarter finals play for the places 5 – 8. The final ranking for the places 5/6 and 7/8 will also be determined on a direct comparison of the results at the other football ground.

Result comparison:

The following criteria apply:

- 1) higher result after normal playing time
- 2) same result, more scored goals, i.e. 3:1 - better than 2:0
- 3) draw, result after the 9 m penalty shoot-out.

Attention: We ask all teams to appear on time for the placement games. Please show fairness and respect to the other teams and play all placement games regardless for which ranking you play! In the case a team doesn't show for the match, this results in a 3:0 victory for the opponent (group match).

Should it be necessary due to weather conditions, the organizer or the organizing team can shorten the match times or decide the Placement matches with a penalty-shoot out. If there is no other possibility we reserve the right to close the field.

Please note: Being there and taking part means sometimes more than winning at all costs!
