

CORDIAL CUP TIROL

Tournament Rules **15th International Cordial Girls Cup**

Organization and implementation: SPG Hopfgarten/Itter and SV Westendorf

The game is played according to the international football rules of UEFA. All games are officiated by certified referees. Match ball is the Adidas Tiro Ball - Gr. 5.

Venues: SPG Hopfgarten/Itter, Marktgasse 22 a; A 6361 Hopfgarten
SV Westendorf, Vorderwindau 2, A 6363 Westendorf

Eligibility to play: U 14/15 (C– juniors) born 2011/2012 and younger

All players must be in possession of an **official player ID**. The player passes or the digital player eligibility list must be submitted to the tournament management before the start of the tournament together with a completed tournament game report form. Players' jersey numbers should match the information on the score sheet. Eligibility checks are carried out by the referees during the tournament. The use of ineligible players means that the player will be excluded from the tournament and the points won will be deducted from the team.

Guest players: the use of guest players is permitted if it is kept within limits and the player has a playing license for the period of the Cordial Girls Cup.

The players concerned must present both the authorization and be able to identify their age.

Game Ban:

Depending on the referee's discretion, a player with a time penalty (=5 minutes) can be excluded during the game, but may return to the game after the time penalty has expired. A temporary field reference can be issued either without a previous warning or after a warning (yellow card). A warning after a FaZ is not permitted. This is followed by a permanent dismissal (red card). A second reference to time is not permitted! For the excluded time, the affected team may not use any other player and must therefore continue playing in the corresponding minority. Only the referee can allow the player to re-enter the game after the time penalty has expired. If a player receives the red card, this means the exclusion for the respective game day. However, if there is a gross violation, such as assault or gross unsportsmanlike conduct, the overall tournament management can determine a complete tournament exclusion. This is also linked to reporting the incident to the respective football association.

player change:

In order to enable more playing time and to optimize the development of the players, each team can use all players (regardless of whether they are field players or goalkeepers) that are listed on the score sheet. However, only two substitution windows per team may be used per game, which must be reported to the referee during a break in the game. A substituted player may be substituted back for the current game, but only in the team's second substitution window.

In the final games (eighth, quarter, semi-finals and final), the half-time break may also be used as a third substitution window.

If a player is injured, he may be replaced without taking into account the two substitution windows, but it is not possible for this player to be substituted back.

A violation of the substitution regulations can lead to a point deduction in the event of a justified protest against the game scoring.

Playing attire:

The team named first in the pairing determines the jersey colour. Please be sure to bring two sets of jerseys in different colors with you. If necessary, colored fitters are used. These will be provided by the tournament management on site.

Game schedule:

The C-Juniors U 15 (10 + 1) play on a normal playing field (large field). The first named team kicks off and always plays from left to right. The preliminary round is played in four groups of five, with everyone competing against everyone else. The winner of a game receives three points, the loser 0 points. In the event of a tie, each team receives 1 point. If there is a tie on points after the end of the preliminary round, the direct comparison decides in the case of two teams with the same number of points; if several teams have the same number of points, a separate table of the teams with the same number of points decides on the final placement! Here, too, the goal difference is the first to be evaluated. If there is also a tie on goal difference, the more goals scored are decisive. If there is a tie here too, the final table of all teams in the group decides first and should there also be a tie, an 11 m shoot-out over the group placement. **UEFA rule!**

Final:

The two winners of the semi-finals contest the final. The final will be part of the Finals of the Cordial Cup Tirol held **in Hopfgarten**.

Placement Matches:

All placement games take place according to the schedule. In the event of a tie after regular tournament play, an immediate 11m shootout will be conducted. Each team designates three players to take the shots on goal, who will take the penalty shootout until the decision is made. If both teams have scored the same number of goals after three 11m, other players from the squad that was on the pitch at the time the game ended will compete and decide in a knockout system.

Award ceremony:

The award ceremony for the teams takes place after the final games at the big award ceremony in Hopfgarten. The tournament winner receives the challenge cup and the Cordial Girls Cup gold medal for each player. The winning team will be invited to the Cordial Girls Cup 2027 including overnight accommodation/HP free of charge for 16 players + 3 coaches. The 2nd placed team receives the silver medal and the 3rd placed team receives the bronze medal.

All other participating teams also receive one tournament medal per player.

The "Player of the match" award will also be presented during the final game!

Tournament Committee:

In the event of any disagreements, the tournament committee, which consists of the chief organizer, a representative of the participating clubs and a representative of the organizing clubs, will decide.

Changing facilities:

Changing facilities will be provided by the organizing clubs. Please understand that the changing facilities are limited due to the large number of participating clubs. The organizer assumes no liability for valuables and clothing.

Meals:

Every player gets a free lunch on the respective sports ground on Saturday
Drink. For this purpose, the respective food stamps are available in the tournament management.
The host clubs will also provide sufficient food and drinks (inexpensive). It is not necessary and also not desired in terms of the event to bring food and drinks with you. On Sunday, the organizing clubs can also provide inexpensive food for the team at the venue. Please arrange this with the responsible persons on site.

Other notes:

The opening ceremony will take place on Friday, May 22nd, 2026 in Kirchberg.
Due to the distance it is up to you to participate - but would be very nice.
We will endeavor to offer an attractive program again. Before the Cordial Cup, the clubs will receive information about the order in which the invasion will take place.

Entrance fees:

Admission to the venues is free for the players and coaches/supervisors.
You will receive the corresponding entry tickets for the trainers/supervisors in the tournament folder.
A contribution towards expenses (5.00 €) must be paid for the parents and accompanying persons at the entrance to the respective venue. The holder of an admission ticket then has free access to all tournament locations of the Cordial Cup Tirol!
